Description: Working on behalf of North Devon District Council, TMS were appointed to complete sea wall repair works to a section of wall in the inner harbour. Areas of the existing wall has signs of existing repairs. The historic harbour which was built in the 12th century has been a popular tourist attraction and is still today a working harbour with fish and seafood being landed daily.



The project was logistically demanding due to the location as access for operatives and materials was extremely difficult to establish at the working area. TMS has undertaken a number of similar repairs and projects. The job was completed, including full project re-design, within an 2-week period to the satisfaction of the Client, North Devon District council.







The original scope of the project included:

- Design of the temporary works system to maintain good access to the working area;
- Mobilisation of site ensuring full site facilities were available;
- Installation of 2 tonne of additional locally sourced walling stone;
- Deconstruction of the seawall and removal of poor backfill and concrete;
- Installation of steel Helifix coils and anchor resin.

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
